I. IDENTIFYING INFORMATION

Position Title:ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR OF CHILD & FAMILY FORMATIONStatus:Full time, Exempt, 12 monthsReports to:Director of Faith FormationStart date:Summer, 2024

II. PRIMARY FUNCTION OF THIS POSITION

The Associate Director provides vision and coordination for the parish family catechetical apostolate to children in grades Pre-K through Grade 6. This includes weekly classroom formation for children as well as parent/family catechesis sessions. The Associate Director designs formation programs which engage and empower parents as the primary catechists of their children. The Associate Director will demonstrate a thorough understanding of Church teaching and be able to transmit it in a way that is both richly informative and deeply transformative.

III. MAJOR POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES AND REGULAR ACTIVITIES

- 1. Develop a vision for child formation (i.e., teaching, equipping and activating missionary disciples) that builds upon and enhances our current offerings. Relatedly, produce a detailed plan to implement this enhanced vision that considers: creative formats, settings, and timeframes; the most effective use of people and campus resources; and increasing the capacity of the number of children and families being served.
- 2. Implement child and family formation programs using curriculum and resources from trusted Catholic publishers that correlate with the Archdiocese of Cincinnati <u>Graded Course of Study</u>, 2018.
- 3. Coordinate the recruitment, training, support, and evaluation of adult volunteers (i.e., catechists and other leaders/aides), to include compliance with the Archdiocesan <u>Decree on Child Protection</u>.
- 4. Coordinate evangelization of and outreach to all children across our parish family, including those with disabilities, and foster the involvement of children in the life of the community.
- 5. Work to engage parents in their responsibility to hand on cherished Catholic heritage and to promote the importance of faith and prayer in the children's everyday lives.
- 6. Conduct summer programming for families and children that is authentically Catholic (i.e., emphasizes both the Word of God and the Sacraments).
- 7. As a parish staff member: attend staff/team meetings; collaborate in team work sessions; communicate to staff/team about apostolate activities; seek staff/team input; submit, manage and maintain an apostolate budget; and serve as a resource to the pastor, staff/team, parish advisory council, et. al., on issues related to child and family formation.

IV. POSITION SPECIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS

1. Active Catholic parishioner in good standing with a consistent prayer life, regular reception of the sacraments, and frequent speaking of his/her relationship with Jesus

- 2. Spiritually mature missionary disciple who actively discerns the movement of the Holy Spirit leading his/her apostolate and personal life
- 3. At ease praying in front of and with others (in both small and large groups), leading and participating in spontaneous prayer and worship
- 4. Strong verbal and written communication skills and the ability to relate to different types of personalities
- 5. Highly adept at organizing detailed activities and prioritizing time efficiently towards the completion of outlined tasks
- 6. Technology savvy with high proficiency in Microsoft Office and Google Workspace
- 7. Regular daytime, evening and weekend work hours required at all three parish campuses (40+ hours per week)
- 8. Working environment: shared work area provided at each campus location (desk/office with computer/printer access); must be able to transport materials and equipment (up to 30 pounds) to and from various locations
- V. KNOWLEDGE, EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE
 - 1. Devout Catholic with thorough knowledge of the Church, including her history, structure, doctrine, and moral teaching
 - 2. Passionate and dynamic teacher grounded in Scripture, the *Catechism*, and the writings of various saints, spiritual masters, and modern-day apologists
 - 3. Bachelor's or Master's Degree in Pastoral Ministry, Religious Studies, Theology, Religious Education, or related field is desirable (Note: we may require a new hire to receive additional training or coursework.)
 - 4. Catechetical Leader certification from the Archdiocese is desirable
 - 5. Previous relevant experience within the parish setting is desirable
